Guidelines for SHORT COMMUNICATIONS

PREPARATION OF AN UP TO 4-PAGE SHORT COMMUNICATION

WHAT IS A SHORT COMMUNICATION?

A short communication is a short research paper of up to four pages focused on one key hypothesis and results, whose ideas and significance can be understood from the short communication. The short communication should contain comparisons to key related works and other details expected in a research paper and include references.

Omitted in a short communication are, for example, everything not related to the key result, future work, and specific details of tests, that are not relevant to the key idea or results.

EXPECTED SECTIONS

Title

Abstract (The original submission or a slightly updated version)

Background leading to research goals & questions, or hypotheses,

Methods and materials (Key design method, material, data collection and analysis)

Results (Short presentation of the key result(s) including e.g. one figure or table)

Discussion (Short discussion of the main result(s) including comparisons to a few key related works and the main conclusion on the aim/hypothesis and its implications).

References (No more than six to eight key references that are cited in text. Do not list uncited references).

GENERAL FORMAT REQUIREMENTS

Same as for full papers

ADVICE TO AUTHORS OF SHORT COMMUNICATIONS

Papers submitted as Short communication should be no more than four A4 pages.
